PARENT PORTAL: The Best Way to get 2018/19 Teacher Assignments

We would like to encourage Parents and Guardians to set up a Parent Portal account before the end of this school year, if you have not already done so. Parent Portal allows you to view your child's attendance, teacher placement for next year, and for Second through Fifth grade you will also be able to view grades. - This year's Kindergarten and First grade parents will received a setup instruction letter in the Wednesday folder on May 2nd.
- Parent Portal will close beginning June 5th and will reopen for parent access to view teacher assignments on Friday August the 10th.

- **If you do not set up your Parent Portal account, then you will receive the teacher assignment through email that same day. Please note: Teacher assignments will not be given over the phone.**
